From the Pastor's Desk

Praise the Holy Trinity! Undivided Unity!

Peace to you! This past Monday, May 20th, we received, by the grace of God, a new Bishop to lead our diocese. Bishop Gerard Battersby was installed. It was a joy to be at the Mass of Installation at the Cathedral with 20+ bishops and, I estimate, about 150 priests, several religious sisters from various religious orders, and hundreds of the faithful from all across the Diocese. It was a beautiful Mass and joy-filled celebration.

This Mass was for me a profound experience of the universal ("catholic") Church! There were representatives of our Hmong parish (Mother of Good Help in Wausau), of our Hispanic ministry parishes, FOCUS missionaries, Knights of Columbus, and many other Catholic organizations throughout our diocese. With people of all ages and vocations, it was a beautiful witness of the Body of Christ, in all of its members. It is difficult to describe this experience unless you have had it. There is a deep spiritual connection that happens. There was a recognition that I am part of something truly amazing, the Communion of Saints, which is everyone united to Jesus Christ throughout the world and throughout all of time.

Because of this, the Installation Mass was, for me, a preview of heaven. The music was amazing, the rituals profound, the depth of prayer powerful. And in the person of our new bishop, we have a visible sign of Christ, the Good Shepherd, who desires to lead us in the ways of the Kingdom of God. He desires to lead us to heaven. It was a preview of the love of the Holy Trinity. This deep mystery of the nature of God Himself, Three Divine Persons in One Divine Substance is the heart of our belief. The three Persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, are distinct, yet not separated or divided. We are called to enter into that Union with God, through the life of grace received through the Sacraments on earth and fulfilled in heaven.

On Friday we wrapped up another great school year at St. Charles School! The students (and teachers!) are excited for summer break, but we will soon be making preparations for the 2024-2025 school year! Decisions about our children's education are big decisions. If you or someone you know has a child turning 4 years old by September 1st, you are invited to come visit our amazing little school this summer!
