I want to particularly thank the members of the Homecoming Planning Committee who put in many hours of work over the past several months. I also thank our raffle ticket donors and other donors: Wal-Stone Dairy for the ½ beef and processing costs for the meat raffle, Jerry and Jim Pedretti for donating the beer, Kevin Mitchell for donating the cost of printing the raffle tickets, and many, many more! I am also grateful to Sheriff Roy Torgerson for coming and for taking two sessions in the dunk tank! It was great to see so many people who are not members of our parish here enjoying themselves and feeling "at home". We have a great parish community!

Keep up the good work of hospitality at our parish. All of us are important in making others either feel welcome or unwelcome at our parish. And since Jesus Christ wants <u>everyone</u> to members of His Body, the Church, we should strive to be hospitable to everyone, even if they don't really like Catholicism or are not interested (yet) in becoming Catholic. If you have any prayer intentions for me and the seminarians to bring on this pilgrimage to the Eucharistic Congress, please let me know! I am grateful that Fr. Kombo and Fr. Zach Edgar will be able to cover the Masses that weekend. Most of you know Fr. Honore Kombo, who is the chaplain at Mayo Hospital in La Crosse. Fr. Zach Edgar is a priest of the Diocese of Springfield, Illinois who is now working full-time at the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in La Crosse with his bishop's and our bishop's permission.

The weekend after that (July 27-28) I will be going with a group of High School students from the La Crosse area to the Steubenville Youth Conference in St. Paul, MN. This conference will be an opportunity for almost 3,000 teens from the upper Midwest to grow in their relationship with Jesus and experience the joy of belonging to the Catholic Church. During that weekend, our Masses will be celebrated by Fr. Merushan Hendrick, who will be leading our annual Mission Co-op. Fr. Merushan is a priest of the Diocese of Batticoloa in Sri Lanka. I will have more info about the Mission Co-op collection in next weekend's bulletin. Thank you in advance for hearing what Fr. Merushan will share about the Church's work in the mission field in Sri Lanka and for your generosity. I am very grateful that our parish has a long history of supporting our brothers and sisters working in the missions to bring Jesus Christ and the Gospel to those who have never heard it.

Please know that although I will be gone a bit during the next couple of weeks, you all remain in my prayers wherever I go, and that when we come together for the Holy Mass, we are not far from each other in spirit, even if we are in miles.
