Stoddard Elementary Summer School

The DeSoto Area Schools will provide an elementary summer school program for grades 4K through 6th grade this summer. Bus schedules will be finalized and sent out soon. The school district will also be providing <u>free</u> <u>breakfast</u> and <u>free lunch</u> to all students in the school district during summer school.

Session 1: Two-week program from June 16-27 for students entering grades K-6. Classes will run from 8:30 a.m. -1:30 p.m., with free breakfast starting at 8:00. If your student is not swimming, pick up will be at 12:00.

Swimming: We will be able to provide free swimming lessons again this summer for students <u>entering grades</u> <u>K-12</u>. A two-week session of swimming lessons at Lansing Pool will be offered during the afternoon of June 16 -June 27. Swimmers will be back around 1:30 at Stoddard. Drop off schedule will come at a later date.

<u>Jump Start Session 2:</u> Two-week "Jump Start" program from July 21-August 1. Classes will run from 8:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. with free breakfast starting at 8:00. This session is designed for students entering 4K-6 grade. Incoming 4K students at Prairie View will have class on Mondays and Wednesdays. Incoming 4K students at Stoddard will have class on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
