From the Pastor's Desk

Let's Revere the Body of Christ

Peace to you! Happy Trinity Feast of the Body and Blood of the Lord ("Corpus Christi")! I am grateful for everyone who will be (or were able) to participate in the Eucharistic Procession after Mass and the potluck farewell reception for me. I am so grateful for each of you here at St. Charles parish, for your faith, your support, and your prayers for me this past 5 years. We are very blessed, and the blessings flow from Jesus Christ. The Eucharist (received in Holy Communion) is Jesus Christ. And so, I am convinced that the blessings of our parish over the past 160+ years have come ultimately from the Eucharist. We enter into that blessing by attending Sunday Mass (or Mass on any day!), by our time of prayer in the church in the presence of the Eucharist in the tabernacle or during Eucharistic Adoration, and by our worthily receiving the Eucharist in Holy Communion.

Worthily receiving the Holy Eucharist has two main aspects: external and internal. The internal aspect involves a few things: 1) Being in a state of grace, that is, your relationship with God is in a good place. What that means practically is that you are not conscious of having committed any serious/mortal sins. If you have, then you would receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation ("confession") before approaching the receive the Eucharist. 2) Being properly disposed. This means having some prayerful recollection when you are receiving Holy Communion, humbly recognizing Whom you are receiving and being awed by that fact.

The external aspect of receiving the Holy Eucharist worthily involves our external comportment of reverence. This involves how we dress when we come to Mass (why not put on our Sunday best when come to Mass and receive Jesus... like we dress when we receive Holy Communion for the first time?), approaching Communion by making a sign of reverence, at least a bow, before we receive, and then saying "Amen" when the priest or extraordinary minister says, "The Body of Christ." One is allowed to receive on the hand or on the tongue, either standing or kneeling. This week, I will have a wide kneeler (called a prie-dieu) at the front of the main aisle so that those who would like to receive the Eucharist kneeling can do so, like our kids and OCIA people do when they received their First Communion. If you have any questions about this, please let me know.
