# From Father Reither's Desk

Greetings from Casa Hogar in Peru! The mission team of 12 students from Aquinas plus myself, the other chaperones, and Fr. Sedlacek have been jumping into the amazing and sometimes chaotic life of the orphanage. As I spoke in my homily last week, a missionary seeks to follow the example of Christ by doing two simple things: to announce the Kingdom of God and to heal the sick. The mission team has been able to get a taste of that life down here by rising early for Mass at 6am every day to pray with the children of Casa Hogar and then to walk them to their school. Later in the morning, they have been helping to repaint the rooms of the orphanage here.

We have also been able to do little "missions" out in the city as well. This morning we brought Holy Communion as Viaticum to a young man who was dying of cancer and we were able to share with him the hope of Christ even in the midst of suffering.

It has been an eye-opening experience for many of our students who have not left the United States before and have not seen firsthand how life is lived by a majority of the world in poverty. At the same time, it has been a good experience to see the joy mixed with suffering that the people here witness with their faith in Jesus Christ.

Thank you for allowing me this time, I know right after I moved in, to lead this mission trip to Casa Hogar. As the students encounter this missionary way of life here in Peru it will be great to have them come back on "reverse mission" to their family and friends back home.

Please continue to pray for a successful trip and a safe journey back home. See you all again soon, Fr. Reither
