While there may not have been much "rejoicing" going on at the airport, we did try to offer the suffering of our commute on behalf of those in need in the Church.

The trip home aside, it was a very fruitful mission trip to our diocesan orphanage of Casa Hogar. For many of our students, this was an eye-opening experience seeing first-hand the poverty and suffering that many people in our world live in, yet at the same time seeing the joy that permeated their lives.
