FROM THE DESK OF FATHER REITHER

Jesus said to his disciples: "I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing!"

Jesus' words sound almost extreme in our Gospel reading today. Fire is a rich symbol in the Bible. It has been used to describe purification, light, destruction, and of course the fire of God's love. All of these symbols could be applied to what Jesus means when he speaks of setting the earth on fire. Sin is purified and destroyed, Jesus is the light of the world, and his love is all consuming. Today we pray especially that we would allow Jesus' love to burn in our hearts through the power of the Holy Spirit.

This week school begins at Aquinas. It is hard to believe that the summer is already coming to an end. As I mentioned before, my assignment here is split in half between St. Charles and Aquinas High School and Middle School as Chaplain.
