<u>From Father Reither:</u> This weekend we celebrate two big feast days in the Church: **November 1st** with All Saints Day and **November 2nd** with All Souls Day. On All S\aints day we celebrate all of the people who are in heaven with Jesus, especially all of the saints who are unknown and don't have a regular feast day. On All Souls Day, we remember in our prayers the souls of those who have died and are in purgatory. It is especially appropriate during the month of November to visit the graves of your loved ones and offer prayer for them. We will have a special Mass this Saturday at 8am for All Saints Day and both weekend Masses will be celebrated for All Souls Day. All are invited to come and pray for the souls of those who have gone before us.
