From the Desk of Father Reither

It was a great blessing for me to be in Rome last week for the diaconate ordination of our seminarian Kyle Lang at St. Peter's Basilica. Deacon Kyle, God willing, will be ordained a priest this coming June. Please keep him in your prayers as he finishes out his last year of seminary formation.

While I was in Rome, I was able to connect with a good friend of mine, Fr. Sedlacek, as he was also leading a pilgrim group over there with members from our own parish and throughout the diocese.

While we were over there, we got to visit Assisi on the feast day of St. Francis. My favorite thing to do in Assisi was to pray in front of the San Damiano Crucifix, the same crucifix that St. Francis heard speaking to him 800 years ago: "Francis, go and rebuild my Church which, as you can see, is falling into ruin." It was truly a blessed experience to be over in Rome and to pray with St. Francis.

I prayed especially for guidance from the Holy Spirit for the Rebuild my Church initiative that our diocese is going through now, as the inspiration from that initiative takes its roots from St. Francis. A reminder that our next closest parish listening session is next Sunday the 19th at 1 PM at Mary Mother of the Church. I am planning on attending and once again I invite all of you to consider coming as well to share in this process of renewal in our diocese. Renewal is first and foremost internal before it is external. All of us should be examining our lives to see how we are growing closer to Christ or how we may be slowly moving away from him and in need of personal conversion.
